Respite Program

Are you caring for a senior or a person with Dementia?

The respite program is designed to give unpaid caregivers a temporary break.

Respite services are available to:

- Caregivers who care for lovedones (60 and older) who need assistance with daily tasks.
- Caregivers for people diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease or related dementia.
- Caregivers age 55+ who are caring for an individual, age 18-59, with a disability.

Older Relative Caregiver Program (ORC)

Are you a senior who is the primary caregiver for children?
